Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was a ban on transfer but however, under the garb of work arrangements basis, she has been transferred which is not

justified. She further submits that during the period of ban, no such transfer is permissible and the ban has just been lifted on 19.06.2026 where as the order was passed on 08.06.2026 and now the respondents are proceeding to relieve her any moment.

Learned counsel further relied upon the judgment passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court in SB Civil Writ Petition No. 7442/2025.

In view of the above, this Court is inclined to interfere in the matter. Issue notice, returnable within two weeks.
