This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.223/2026 registered at Police Station Sadar, Ganganagar, District Sri Ganganagar, for offences under Sections 8/22 of NDPS Act and 223(B) of BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case out of the recoveries of the tablet effected only the tablet tramadol falls under the NDPS Act and the recovery of which is 80 gms. which is below commercial. He submits that so far as the alleged tablet Pregabalin and Tapentadol concerned they do not fall under the schedule of the NDPS Act, that apart only one case is pending against the petitioner which is also of BNS and there is no other NDPS case is pending or registered against the petitioner and petitioner is behind the bars since 06.06.2026

and investigation from petitioner is complete and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

This Court has considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case as well as perused the material available on record; in the present case out of the recoveries of the tablet effected only the tablet Tramadol falls under the NDPS Act and the recovery of which is 80 gms. which is below commercial. So far as the alleged tablet Pregabalin and Tapentadol concerned they do not fall under the schedule of the NDPS Act, that apart only one case is pending against the petitioner which is also of BNS and there is no other NDPS case is pending or registered against the petitioner and petitioner is behind the bars since 06.06.2026 and investigation from petitioner is complete; the investigation/trial will take sufficient time to conclude; without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Narendra Kumar @ Nandu S/o Shri Premkumar Meghwal** arrested in connection with FIR No.223/2026 registered at Police Station Sadar, Ganganagar, District Sri Ganganagar, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his

appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and
whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
