This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with FIR No.157/2026 registered at Police Station CPS Jaipur, ACB District for offences under Sections 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case as the phenolphthalein powder test did not yield any result. It is further contended that the alleged recovery is of Rs. 4,000/- only and petitioner is behind the bars since 10.06.2026. The trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

This Court has considered the rival submissions and considered the facts and circumstances of the case. The phenolphthalein powder test did not yield any result and recovery is only of Rs. 4,000/- in the present matter also, petitioner is in judicial custody since 10.06.2026. Keeping in view the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take sufficient long time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Bunty Meena S/o Shri Jainarayan Meena**, arrested in connection with FIR No.157/2026 registered at Police Station CPS Jaipur, ACB District shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
