1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is stated to be living in live-in relationship with the corpus Mst. 'P'. It is stated that the corpus is in illegal detention of the private respondents.

3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'P' has been produced before us.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'P'. The corpus Mst. 'P' has stated that she is 28 years of age, has studied uptill 12th Standard and understands her well being quite well. She has further stated that she was married to the respondent No.5 and is having two children. However, on account of maltreatment at the hands of the respondent No.5, she left her matrimonial home and started living with the petitioner in live-in relationship. The corpus Mst. 'P' has also stated that she is desirous of living with the present petitioner. She has further stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person and is living with her parents.

5. We have considered the statements made before us and we are of the view that since the corpus Mst. 'P' is a major educated lady, therefore, she is free to live at a place and with a person of her own choice.

6. In view of the discussion made above, the present habeas corpus petition is disposed of with liberty to the corpus Mst. 'P' to live at a place and with a person of her own choice.

7. The Investigating Agency is directed to provide adequate security to the corpus Mst. 'P' till she reaches the place of her choice.

8. The amount of Rs.25,000/- deposited by the petitioner under the directions issued by this Court shall be refunded to him.
