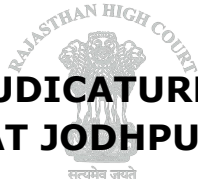

1. The petitioners have preferred the present writ petition claiming the following prayer:

"It is, therefore, most respectfully and humbly prayed that this writ petition (PIL) may kindly be accepted and allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction:-

(i) The respondent authorities may kindly be restrained from shifting the 33 KV electricity line (Mokalsar Feeder emanating from 132 KV GSS Siwana).

(ii) The order dated 18.01.2026 (Annex.03) issued by the Superintending Engineer (O&M) Jodhpur Discom, Balotra may kindly be quashed and set aside.

(iii) Any other appropriate writ, order or direction which deems fit in the facts & circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner;

(iv) The writ petition may kindly be allowed with cost."

2. At the threshold, Mr. D.S. Sodha, learned counsel appearing for the respondent - J.V.V.N.L. submits that the grievance of the petitioner is being considered at the earliest and issues raised herein, including the consideration of the revised rules, shall be duly taken into consideration.

3. In light of such submission, the present writ petition is disposed of.
