This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner, who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.152/2026 registered at Police Station, Begun, District Chittorgarh for the offence under Sections 8/15 and 29 of NDPS Act.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that contraband recovered is 45 Kg & 400 Grams of Poppy Straw (Doda Chura), which is below the commercial quantity as prescribed under the Schedule enumerated under the NDPS Act. Antecedents of petitioner-Manaram is clear, as there is no previous case under the NDPS Act

and so far as accused-Raju is concerned, only one case is pending against him under IPC offences. The petitioners no.1 & 2 are behind bars since 12.6.2026 and 10.6.2026 respectively. The trial of case will take a sufficiently long time, therefore, benefit of bail may be granted to the petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case; recovery being below commercial quantity; antecedents of petitioners being clear; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case they are enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioners **(1) Manaram S/o Shri Noratram and (2) Raju S/o Shri Kaluram** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.152/2026 registered at Police Station, Begun, District Chittorgarh shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided each of them furnish a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for their appearance before that



court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
