This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner, who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.120/2026 registered at Police Station, Bigod, District Bhilwara for the offence under Section 8/15 of NDPS Act.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the recovered contraband is 29.09 Kg Poppy Straw (Doda Chura), which is below the commercial quantity as prescribed under the Schedule enumerated under the NDPS Act. The antecedents of petitioner is clear, as there is no previous case pending against him. He is behind bars since 12.6.2026. The trial of case will take a sufficiently long time, therefore, benefit of bail may be granted to the petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case; recovery being below commercial quantity; antecedents of petitioner being clear; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Mahendra S/o Shri Raymal Gurjar** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.120/2026 registered at Police Station, Bigod, District Bhilwara shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
