Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the identical case **Ranveer Chopra S/o Deva Ram & Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.** of **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 12525/2026**, the Coordinate Bench of this Court has passed an interim order after considering the matter and the same reads as under:-

- "1. Heard on the interim stay application.*
- 2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the impugned termination order has been passed on the ground that there was no sanction for continuation of the posts for which, the petitioners were recruited on contract basis. Their submissions are that the present impugned order has only been passed so as to enable the employer to recruit fresh employees on contract basis.*
- 3. Having considered the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the respondents are directed to continue the services of the petitioners, if the scheme is extended and they are restrained from replacing the services of the petitioners with another new set of employees.*

4. *Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.*
5. *Connect with S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.7057/2026"*

It is stated that the case of the petitioners is absolutely identical and is based upon the same facts and cause. In view of the same, this Court is inclined to interfere in the case.

Hence, having considered the submissions made, the respondents are directed to continue the services of the petitioners, if the scheme is extended and they are restrained from replacing the services of the petitioners with another new set of employees.

Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.
