Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in **SBCWP No.645/2025**; titled as **M/s Tata Bricks Company Vs. Rajasthan State Pollution Control Borad & Ors.** vide order dated 30.10.2025, it has been held by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, that the polluter pays principle and the environmental compensation will only be applicable when there is a specific formula and appropriate procedure have been carried out. It is submitted that in the instant matter, notice dated 30.03.2026 (Annex.5) which has been issued imposing Rs. 10.18 Lakhs upon the petitioner, is without any formula and basis.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of petition in the office of Mr. S.S. Rathore, AAG.

Qua respondent No.4, notices be served upon in the office of Shri Rajesh Panwar.

On the next date, learned counsel for respondents is directed to apprise the Court whether against the order passed in **SBCWP No.645/2025**, any appeal has been preferred or the order is accepted.

Undersigning authority of the notice dated 30.03.2026 is directed to remain present before this Court on the next date of hearing and explain that why in the environmental matters, compensation has been awarded, sans consideration of lawful procedure.

List the matter on 20.07.2026 in the supplementary cause list at 02:00 pm.

In the meantime, no coercive action be taken against the petitioner.

It is made clear that the interim protection shall become operational subject to service upon the respondents.
