Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has raised strong objections during the course of the hearing. It is vehemently submitted that the calculation of compensation has already been duly carried out by the competent authorities and the same has been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents has further placed reliance upon the settled proposition of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **D.P.C.C. vs. Union of India through Secretary** passed in **Civil Appeal No.757-760/2013**, contending that a Writ Court should be extremely slow and circumspect in entertaining such writ petitions and granting interim equitable relief.
