1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicants-accused **1. Amarjeet Kaur W/o Rajkumar @ Raju and 2. Smt Jasmail Kaur W/o Hazara Singh**, seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.46/2026 dated 16.02.2026 registered at P.S. Tibbi, District - Hanumangarh, for the offence under Sections 103(1), 238(a), 140(1), 316(2), 61(2) and 189(2) of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more

required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicants accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicants undertake not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are female and they are entitled to get bail only on the ground that they are female. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the main allegation is upon Malkit Singh and Rajkumar alias Raju and recovery has been effected at the instance of both. He further submitted that neither is there any evidence nor any connecting circumstances to implicate these petitioners in the incident. He also submits that even the investigating agency has recommended both the petitioners only for involvement in the conspiracy with main accused Malkit Singh and Rajkumar alias Raju. He further submits that the investigation is complete and both the accused are in custody since their arrest on 19th February 2026.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature. He has also filed a report received from concerned Police Station.
5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. After missing of son of complainant "Ramdas", the complainant Sewa Singh has lodged MPR No. 6/2026 at PS

Tibbi, District Hanumangarh, alleging that he is missing since 27th January 2026 and after recovery of dead body, an FIR No.46/2026 was registered with the allegation that the son of complainant "Ramdas" went to recover ₹4 Lakh from Malkit Singh and after non-return, a MPR was registered but after recovery of dead body, the complainant has suspected that Ramdas was killed by Malkit Singh, Raju Singh, wife of Raju Singh, Ram Singh, Jasmail Kaur, wife of Krishan Singh, wife of Malkit Singh and Bhim Singh so as to misappropriate the money.

7. After registration of FIR, the matter has been investigated by police and on basis of intimation given by Malkit Singh @ Meetu, Rajkumar @ Raju Singh, certain recoveries were effected. Both the petitioners Amarjeet Kaur and Smt Jasmail Kaur were arrested on the charge that they have conspired with main accused Malkit Singh and Rajkumar. A chargesheet has already been filed and there is no direct allegations against both the petitioners.
8. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
9. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicants-accused **1. Amarjeet Kaur W/o Rajkumar @**

Raju and 2. Smt Jasmail Kaur W/o Hazara Singh, are hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

10. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
