This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS has been
filed by the petitioners, who have been arrested in connection
with F.I.R. No.158/2026 registered at Police Station, Srivijaynagar,
District Sri Ganganagar for the offence under Sections 8/21, 25
and 29 of NDPS Act.

Counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that from accused Noor Masih and co-accused Navjot Singh @ Jyoti, the police is said to have allegedly recovered contraband Heroine weighing 75 Grams and 126 Grams respectively, which is below the prescribed commercial quantity as enumerated under the Schedule of NDPS Act. The antecedents of petitioners are clear. They are behind bars since 09.6.2026. The trial of case will take a sufficiently long time, therefore, benefit of bail may be granted to the petitioners.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case; recovery being below commercial quantity; antecedents of petitioners being clear; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case they are enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioners (1) **Noor Masih S/o Kulwant Masih** (CRLMB No.8406/2026) (2) **Navjot Singh Alias Jyoti S/o Kuldeep Singh** (CRLMB No.8407/2026) arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.158/2026 registered at Police

Station, Srivijaynagar, District Sri Ganganagar shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided each of them furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for their appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
