Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The present writ petition has been filed by the father of the corpus Mst. 'K', who is stated to be in the illegal detention of respondent No.4.

In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, Mst. 'K' has been produced before us.

We have conferred with the corpus. She stated that she is 16 years of age and has completed her secondary school education.



She stated that she left her parental house on account of the fact that she was being engaged with a person who she did not like and since her parents were forcing her to marry the person who is not of her choice, she left the house.

The corpus has expressed her desire to go with the present petitioner who is her father and she has also stated that she was not in illegal detention of any person including the respondent No.4.

In view of the statements made before us the present writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the investigating agency to hand over the custody of the corpus Mst. 'K' to the present petitioner.
