Order

1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking following relief:

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that this writ petition may kindly be allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction the impugn Notice dated 11.06.2026 (Annex.1) issued by the respondent No.4 may kindly be declared illegal and be accordingly quashed and set aside. A further direction may be issued to the respondents to not to demolish the



construction of petitioner society in violation of the direction issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.”

2. Counsel representing the parties, at the outset, jointly submit that the issue involved in the writ petition is squarely covered by the judgment dated 13.07.2026 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court at Jodhpur in ***SBCWP No.13243/2026 : Peer Mohammad Shah Jilani Dargah Samiti v. State of Rajasthan & Ors.*** (along with other connected bunch of petitions); whereby, the Coordinate Bench of this Court has dismissed the writ petitions.

3. Thus, in view of the submissions made by counsel representing the parties, the instant writ petition stands dismissed in the same terms as in the case of *Peer Mohammad Shah Jilani Dargah Samiti (supra)*.

4. Stay application as well as all other pending applications, if any, also stand dismissed.
