1. Heard.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has shown to this Court an
order dated 14.08.2023 passed by a coordinate Bench of this
Hon'ble Court at Jaipur Bench in ***Khandelwal Teachers Training
College & Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors. : S.B. Civil Writ
Petition No.12207/2023***, which reads as follows:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue involved
in this writ petition has been considered by the Co-ordinate
Bench of this Court in the matter of Shorya Education
Institute Vs. Maharaja Surajmal Brij University & Anr. (S.B.
Civil Writ Petition No.20749/2019) wherein on 11.12.2019,
the following order was passed:-

"Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is contended by learned counsel for petitioner that under Section 13 of the NCTE Act, 1993, it is the Council which is competent only for carrying out the inspection of B.Ed Colleges and not the affiliating University.

Issue notice to the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to serve a copy of the writ petition in the office of Mr. Vinod Kumar Gupta, learned counsel appearing for the University as well as in the Office of Dr. Vibhuti Bhushan Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General for the respondent No.2, during course of the day.

List the matter on 18.12.2019 along with SB CWP No.18748/2019.

In the meanwhile, in pursuance of the order dated 30.11.2019 (Annexure-7), no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner-Institute."

In that view of the matter, issue notice to the respondent(s), returnable on 10.10.2023.

Meanwhile, in pursuance to the order dated 17.07.2023, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner."

3. List on 11.09.2023 after showing the name of Mr. Manish Vyas, AAG for the respondents in the cause list.
4. In the meanwhile, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner in pursuance of the order dated 18.08.2023 (Annexure-4).
