1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is the mother of the corpus Mst. 'K' and it is stated that the corpus Mst. 'K' is in illegal detention of some persons.



3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this court, the corpus Mst. 'K' has been produced before this Court.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'K'. She stated that she is 21 years of age, having educational qualification of senior secondary and understands her well being quite well. She stated before us that she has solemnized marriage with one Ajeet and is living with him in her matrimonial home happily and without any pressure from any side. She stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person including her husband Ajeet. She has refused to meet the petitioner or her parents. She stated that she has expressed the threat at the hands of her family and, therefore, she prayed for protection till she reaches her matrimonial home.

5. In view of the statements made by the corpus Mst. 'K' before us, this Court is convinced that the corpus Mst. 'K' is not in illegal detention of any person and since she is a major literate lady, therefore, she is free to go and live at a place and with a person of her choice.

6. The present habeas corpus petition is, therefore, fails, and the same is hereby dismissed.

7. The investigating agency is directed to see to it that the corpus Mst. 'K' reaches her matrimonial home safely.
