**HON'BLE DR. JUSTICE NUPUR BHATI****Order****03/07/2026**

1. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners with following prayers:-

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(i) The respondents may kindly be directed to grant the 1st selection scale, 2nd selection scale and 3rd selection scale on completion of 9, 18 and 27 years of service to the petitioners from the date it becomes due along with arrear of salary and interest thereon @18%.

(ii) The respondents further directed to grant the arrear of salary for the selection scales on completion of 9, 18 and 27 years of service from the date it actually become due along with 18% interest.

(iii) The respondents may kindly be directed to grant 1st selection scale, 2nd selection scale and 3rd selection scale to the petitioners on completion of 9, 18 and 27 years of service while counting the seniority from the date of initial appointment.

2. During course of arguments, learned counsel for petitioners while referring order dated **03.05.2023 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 6074/2023 titled as “Bhanwar Nath and Ors. Vs. Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation & Ors”** decided by a Co-ordinate Bench at Principal Seat, Jodhpur submits that the petitioners may be granted permission to file an appropriate representation before the respondents-Authority to consider and resolve their grievances in light to ratio decided on **25.01.2017 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 8810/2014 “Tara Chand Vs. Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation & Anr.”**

3. Learned counsel for the respondent is not in a position to refute the same.

4. Considered the grievance raised herein, the petitioners are given a liberty to submit a representation to the respondents-Authority within



a period of 30 days raising all grounds and the respondents-Authority are directed to decide the representation in light of ratio as laid down in case of **Tara Chand Vs. Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation (supra)**, and relied in case of **Bhanwar Nath and Ors. Vs. Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation (supra)**. In case of deviation, the respondents are directed to decide the representation with a reasoned and speaking order within a period of 30 days from date of receipt of representation. After passing the order, the respondents are under an obligation to communicate the decision to the petitioners either by way of speed post or through E-mail, if petitioners have provided E-mail in their representation. If the petitioners are still aggrieved, they have a liberty to approach this Court with fresh petition.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition with pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
