1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the
friend of the corpus Mst. 'A' alleging therein that she is in illegal
detention of the private respondents.

3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'A' has been produced before us.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'A'. The corpus Mst. 'A' has stated that she 23 years of age, has studied up till 12th standard and she understands her well-being quite well. She has stated that she knew the petitioner and, therefore, they decided to solemnize marriage. However, the parents of the corpus are not agree for her marriage with the present petitioner. She has expressed her desire to go and live with the present petitioner only and refused to go with her parents. She has stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person including private respondents.

5. We have considered the statements made before us and we are of the view that since the corpus Mst. 'A' is 23 years of major literate lady and she is not in illegal detention of any person, therefore, she is free to live at a place of her own choice.

6. In view of the discussion made above, the present habeas corpus petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating agency to handover the custody of the corpus to the petitioner. The investigating agency is further directed to provide adequate security to the corpus till she reaches the place of her choice.

7. The amount of Rs.25,000/- deposited by the petitioner under the directions issued by this Court shall be refunded to him.
