1. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends, *inter alia*, that the allegations in the FIR, *ex facie*, reflect that the relationship, if any, between the prosecutrix and the petitioner was purely consensual, though the petitioner strongly refutes the same. Learned counsel further submits that a detailed representation has already been given to the Investigating Officer, wherein it has been detailed that there was a property transaction going on between the parties, which did not fructify and peeved by the same, as a retaliatory measure, the FIR in question has been registered making false allegations.

2. Issue notice.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 - State. Let notice be issued to respondent No.2.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor seeks time to file a report.
5. Meanwhile, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner qua the FIR in question. However, petitioner shall join the investigation as and when summoned by the Investigating Officer.
