Order

1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Saddam Hussain S/o Ahmed Hussain**, seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.141/2026 dated 28.05.2026 registered at P.S. Bichhwal, District - Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 325 of BNS and Section 3/8 of the Rajasthan Bovine Animal (Prohibition of Temporary Migration or Export) Act, 1995.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that initially this petitioner was detained under Section 170 of BNSS and further was released on execution of bond for keeping peaceful behavior under Section 126 of BNSS. He also submits that thereafter a report was registered by complainant against the petitioner and the present petitioner was arrested on 8th June 2026 and a charge sheet has already been filed.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor as well as learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and very serious in nature. Learned Public Prosecutor has also filed a report received from concerned Police Station.
5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On 28-05-2026, complainant Rup Singh has registered a report about incident dated 23rd May 2026, alleging that the present petitioner has killed a cow after committed cruelty. The police has registered an FIR No.141/2026 under sections

325 of BNS and Sections 3/8 the Rajasthan Bovine Animal (Prohibition of Temporary Migration or Export) Act, 1995. The present petitioner was arrested on 8th June 2026 and as per report, a charge sheet has already been filed. There is no criminal antecedents against the petitioner. Earlier the petitioner was arrested under Section 170 of BNSS, and further was bound under Section 126 of BNSS by the Executive Magistrate.

7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Saddam Hussain S/o Ahmed Hussain**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.

(iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.

(iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
