Order

1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicants-accused **Raju Mandal S/o Shri Akash** and **Subrat Ali Alias Sobrat Ali Sheikh S/o Mohammad Ali Sheikh**, seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.58/2026 dated

06.06.2026 registered at P.S. Kotwali Bikaner, District - Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 306 BNS, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicants accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicants undertake not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner accused Subrat Ali @ Sobrat Ali Sheikh is not named in FIR whereas the petitioner accused Raju Mandal was working with complainant. He further submits that as per police report, recovery has already been effected. He further submits that there is no criminal antecedents against the petitioners, who are in custody since their arrest on 09.06.2026/10.06.2026.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor and learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature. Learned Public Prosecutor has also filed a report received from concerned Police Station.
5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a report dated 06.06.2026, an FIR No. 58/2026 was registered at PS Kotwali Bikaner, District Bikaner against

petitioner Raju Mandal. During investigation, police has recovered a gold rod bearing weight of 75.480 grams. There is no criminal antecedents against the petitioners.

7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicants-accused **Raju Mandal S/o Shri Akash** and **Subrat Ali Alias Sobrat Ali Sheikh S/o Mohammad Ali Sheikh**, is hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing each of them a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.

(iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
