1. The present writ petition has been filed challenging the notification dated 12.03.2025 to the extent of the name of newly created revenue village.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the issue involved in the present case can be resolved by issuing appropriate directions to the respondents No.1 & 2 to consider the representation of the petitioners in light of judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 19.12.2025 passed in **SLP (C)**

No. 27965/2025 titled Bhika Ram & Anr. Vs. State Of Rajasthan & Ors.

3. The present writ petition is disposed of while granting the liberty to petitioners to file representation ventilating their grievances before respondents No.1 & No.2, within a period of 10 days from the date of passing of this order. Respondents No.1 & No.2 are directed to decide the same strictly in accordance with law, so also in accordance with the judgments passed by this Court and as well as by the Hon'ble Apex Court. The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of this order.

4. With these observations, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of.

5. Stay application and all pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
