1. The present temporary suspension of sentence application has been filed on behalf of the applicant under Section 430 BNSS (389 of Cr.P.C.) seeking temporary suspension of sentence awarded to him by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jayal, District Nagaur (hereinafter referred to as 'trial Court') vide order dated 14.01.2026 passed in Session Case No. 90/2023 on account of illness of his father.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant's father is suffering from serious ailment of Kidney and he is admitted in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). He, therefore,

prays that the sentence awarded to the applicant may be temporarily suspended for a period of 30 days to look after the well-being of his father.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has verified the factum of applicant's father suffering from Kidney ailment and he is admitted in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). It has also been reported in the report dated 04.07.2026 that there is no other able member in the family to look after the well-being of the applicant's father.

4. The report dated 04.07.2026 is taken on record.

5. We have considered the submissions made at the bar and have gone through the relevant record of the case.

6. In view of the aforesaid, the present application seeking temporary suspension of sentence is allowed and it is ordered that the substantive sentence passed by the learned trial court vide judgment dated 14.01.2026 passed in Session Case No.90/2023 against the applicant –**Shailendra Singh @ Shyam Singh S/o Shri Ranjeet Singh** shall remain temporarily suspended for a period of 30 days' from the date of his actual release provided he executes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) with two sureties in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) out of which one surety will be of his close relative, each to the satisfaction of the concerned Jail Superintendent on usual conditions. He shall surrender back before the concerned Jail Superintendent after completion of 30 days' from the date of his actual release. The concerned Jail Superintendent shall give a date of his surrender.

7. Let this application seeking interim suspension of sentence be again listed on **12.08.2026**, and on that date, learned Public Prosecutor and learned counsel for the petitioner shall submit the compliance of this order.
