1. The instant bail applications have been filed by the applicants
**Ashok Bhambu S/o Bhura Ram, Prahlad Ram S/o Nema
Ram and Ram Prasad S/o Nema Ram** under Section 483 BNSS

against the order impugned passed by learned court below in connection with **FIR No.70/2026** registered at **Police Station Rol District Nagaur** for the offence(s) under **Sections 189(2), 126(2), 115(2), 324(4), 109(1) of BNS and Section 3/25 of Arms Act.**

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that he does not want to press the bail application of accused applicant **Ram Prasad S/o Nema Ram** with liberty to file fresh bail application after filing of challan.

3. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS filed by the accused-applicant **Ram Prasad S/o Nema Ram** is dismissed as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.

4. As regards applicants **Ashok Bhambu S/o Bhura Ram, Prahlad Ram S/o Nema Ram**, learned counsel submits that they have been falsely implicated in the case. He further submits that the main allegation of firing is against Ram Prasad and the present accused were merely accompanying him. Learned counsel submits that applicants are behind the bars and trial may take long time to conclude thus, they deserve to be enlarged on bail.

5. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail applications.

6. Considering the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, and looking to the overall facts and circumstances of the case, without commenting on the merits and demerits of the case, this court deems it just and proper to enlarge the applicants **Ashok Bhambu S/o Bhura Ram, Prahlad Ram S/o Nema Ram** on bail.

7. The bail applications under Section 483 BNSS filed by accused-applicants **Ashok Bhambu S/o Bhura Ram, Prahlad Ram S/o Nema Ram**, are allowed and it is ordered that the

accused-applicants shall be enlarged on bail in the aforesaid FIR provided they furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned Lower Court for their appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
