Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and the prosecutrix were already living together in a live-in relationship. However, owing to differences that arose between them, the prosecutrix lodged the present FIR. It is further submitted that the parties have since reconciled and are now residing together. The prosecutrix is also stated to be pregnant with the child of the petitioner.

In these circumstances, it is submitted that the parties have amicably settled their dispute and are living together peacefully.

Consequently, nothing survives for further continuation of the present FIR.

Learned Public Prosecutor submits that, after a thorough investigation, the police have decided to file a negative final report before the competent Court.

In view of the above, the instant criminal miscellaneous petition stands disposed of.
