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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE ASHOK KUMAR JAIN**  
**Order**

**17/07/2026**

1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Durgaram S/o Paldevaram** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.65/2026 dated 11.03.2026 registered at P.S. Hamirwas, District - Churu, for the offence under Sections 109(1), 115(2), 126(2), 331(6) & 189(2) of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that with general and omnibus allegations, FIR has been registered on basis of *Parcha Bayan* of injured Rajesh. He also submitted that none of the injured has sustained injury on any of the vital part. He also submitted that two other accused Bhagirath and Sharmila Devi were granted bail by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. He also submitted that out of nine criminal cases registered against the applicant, four cases have been disposed of and others are of trivial nature.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of *Parcha-Bayan* recorded on 11.03.2026 about incident of early hours of 11.03.2026, FIR No.65/2026 was registered at Police Station Hamirwas, District Churu. During investigation both the injured Rajesh and Rajendra were examined by medical jurist and however the opinion were given by the medical jurist the opinion clearly indicate that except one grievous injury upon Rajesh other injuries are simple in nature whereas there were commuted fracture of Tibia & Fibula upon other injured Rajendra Kumar, which are on non-vital part. Accused Bhagirath was granted bail on 27.04.2026 and Sharmila Devi was granted bail on 01.05.2026.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in

the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.

8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Durgaram S/o Paldevaram**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
