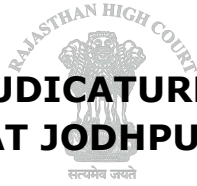

1. Learned counsel representing the petitioner, at the outset,
makes a limited submission that the respondents may be directed
to consider and decide the pending undated representation dated
(Annex.2) filed by the petitioner, by way of passing a speaking
order, within a particular time period.
2. In light of such limited submission, it is hereby directed that
the pending undated representation (Annex.2) filed by the
petitioner shall be decided by the respondents by way of passing a
speaking order strictly in accordance with law within a period of
'four weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

3. With the aforesaid direction, the instant writ petition is disposed of. Stay application as well as all other pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.

4. It is made clear that aforesaid direction to decide there presentation has been issued only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of petitioners' grievance. The same may not be construed to be an order to decide the representation in a particular manner.
