So far as the writ petitioner is concerned, she has studied Hindi as compulsory subject in all three years of her Bachelor of Arts, whereafter she was awarded degree of B.A. She has also done M.A. in Hindi. However appellant-RPSC submits that because the word used against Hindi is compulsory, it cannot be treated as optional.
2. Ordinarily, any subject, which is studied continuously for three years in graduation would be treated as an optional subject.
3. Learned counsel for the appellant wants time to explain the difference between an optional subject and a compulsory subject, which may have been pursued for all three years.
4. List this case again on 3rd August, 2026.
5. On the next date of hearing, learned counsel for the appellant shall also place on record the details of the lesser meritorious persons, who have been given appointment.
