1. This application for bail has been filed by the petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS (old Section 439 of Cr.P.C.). The requisite details of the matter are tabulated herein below:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the case and false allegations have been levelled against them. He further submits that the injuries sustained by the injured are simple in nature and that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents. Learned counsel further contends that the principal allegation of inflicting the sword injury is against the co-accused- Kanhaiya Lal and no such specific allegation has been levelled against the present petitioners. The petitioner- Pintu Singh is in judicial custody since 13.05.2026 and petitioner Deepak Bhoi is in judicial custody since 15.05.2026 and the trial will take sufficiently long time, therefore, they deserve to be enlarged on bail.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes this bail application.

4. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.

5. Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of this case and after perusing the case diary so also considering the fact that the injuries sustained by the injured

are simple in nature; the petitioners have no criminal antecedents; the principal allegation of inflicting the sword injury is against the co-accused - Kanhaiya Lal; no such specific allegation has been levelled against the present petitioners, in the considered opinion of this Court, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars for an indefinite period as the trial will take sufficiently long time. Thus, without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that the bail application filed by the petitioners deserves to be accepted.

6. Accordingly, the bail applications filed under Section 483 of BNSS are allowed. It is ordered that petitioners- **Pintu Singh S/o Maan Singh** and **Deepak Bhoi S/o Mohanlal**, shall be released on bail in connection with the aforesaid FIR; provided they execute personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with two sound and solvent sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of learned trial Court for their appearance before that court on each and every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till the completion of the trial.

7. It is however, made clear that findings recorded/observations made above are for limited purposes of adjudication of bail application. The trial court shall not get prejudiced by the same.
