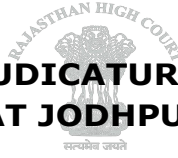

1. The instant bail application has been filed by the applicants **Jitendra S/o Galbaram @ Gulab, Pakaram @ Prakash S/o Bhuraram** under Section 483 BNSS against the order impugned passed by learned court below in connection with **FIR No.90/2026** registered at **Police Station Falna District Pali** for the offence(s) under **Sections 126(2), 115(2), 140(3), 303(2) & 3(5) of BNS.**
2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the case. The matter is triable by Magistrate. Learned counsel further submits that co-accused Lalit has already been enlarged on bail by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 25.6.2026. He further submits that



applicants are behind the bars and trial may take long time to conclude thus, they deserve to be enlarged on bail.

3. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

4. Considering the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties and looking to the overall facts and circumstances of the case, without commenting on the merits and demerits of the case, this court deems it just and proper to enlarge the applicants on bail.

5. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-applicants shall be enlarged on bail in the aforesaid FIR provided they furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned Lower Court for their appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
