1. The present second bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Jitendra Singh @ Raju S/o Bishan Singh** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.115/2026 dated 23.06.2026 registered at Police Station Sameja Kothi, District Sriganganagar, for the offence under Section 8/21 of NDPS Act.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant-accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the

applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that 8.68 grams of heroin has allegedly been recovered from the possession of present petitioner and petitioner is in custody since 23.06.2026. He further submits that the police has not complied with the mandatory provisions prescribed under NDPS Act before effecting search and seizure.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
6. On basis of interception and search on 23.06.2026 by SHO, Police Station Sameja Kothi, District Sriganganagar, 8.68 grams heroin was recovered from possession of present petitioner and on basis of seizure memo, FIR No.115/2026 under Section 8/21 of NDPS Act was registered against the petitioner. Petitioner-accused is in custody since his arrest on 27.06.2026. The recovered quantity is less than commercial quantity. There is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner.
7. This Court also finds that the applicant-accused has remained in custody for a considerable period of time and that the trial is likely to take further time to conclude. Therefore, looking to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any

opinion on the merits thereof, this Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.

8. Thus, the instant second bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Jitendra Singh @ Raju S/o Bishan Singh**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
