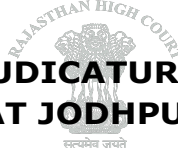

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.



2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner, who claims to be the husband of the corpus Mst. 'L'. It is alleged that the corpus Mst. 'L' is in illegal detention of the private respondents.

3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'L' is produced before this Court.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'L'. She stated that she is a 20 years of age, having educational qualification up till 12th class and understands her well being quite well. She stated that she has solemnized marriage with the present petitioner of her own free will. She expressed her desire to go and live with the present petitioner. She stated that she does not want to go and live with her parents. She further stated that on earlier occasion when the habeas corpus petition was filed by her brother, she has made the same statement and has expressed her desire to go and live with the present petitioner only.

5. In view of the statements made before us by the corpus Mst. 'L', we are of the view that since the corpus Mst. 'L' is a major literate lady of 20 years of age, who understands her well being, and she has expressed her desire to go with the present petitioner, therefore, she is free to go and live with the present petitioner at her own choice.

6. The present Habeas Corpus Petition is disposed of and the corpus Mst. 'L' is free to go and live at a place and with a person of her own choice.

7. The investigating agency is directed to see to it that the corpus Mst. 'L' reaches her matrimonial home safely.



8. It is directed that the amount deposited by the present petitioner in pursuance of the directions issued by this Court on 02.07.2026 shall be refunded to the petitioner forthwith.
