1. Learned counsel representing the petitioner, at the outset, makes a limited submission that petitioners would be satisfied if the respondents Nos.1 and 2-Principal Secretary, Department Public Health And Engineering Department (Phed), Secretariat, Jaipur and Executive Engineer, Public Health and Engineering Department (PHED), Utpadak Vitaran and Rejaswa Khand III, Bikaner, may be directed to consider and decide the



representation of the petitioners by way of passing a speaking order within a particular time period.

2 In light of such limited submission, it is hereby directed that the petitioners shall submit a detailed representation to the respondents Nos.1 and 2-Principal Secretary, Department Public Health And Engineering Department (Phed), Secretariat, Jaipur and Executive Engineer, Public Health and Engineering Department (PHED), Utpadak Vitaran and Rejaswa Khand III, Bikaner for ventilating their grievances. The said representation shall be decided by way of passing a speaking order strictly in accordance with law within a period of 'four weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

3 With the aforesaid direction, the instant writ petition is disposed of. Stay application as well as all other pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
