**S.B. Criminal Misc. Suspension of Sentence Application
(Appeal) No. 231/2026**

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner-applicant and the learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the impugned judgments.

I have heard and considered the submissions advance by learned counsel representing the parties and perused the judgments of the courts below. Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case and the short sentence awarded by the learned trial court, I consider it just and proper to suspend the sentences awarded to the accused petitioner-applicant.

Accordingly, the application for suspension of sentence filed under Section 438(1) BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the sentences passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Nathdwara, District Rajsamand in Cr. Original Case No.443/2016 (C.I.S. No.1050/2016) vide order dated 20.04.2023 as affirmed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Nathdwara, District Rajsamand vide order dated 19.11.2025 passed in Cr. Appeal No.05/2023 (C.I.S. No.05/2023) against the petitioner-applicant **Panna Lal S/o Sh Lalu Ram Gayari**, shall remain suspended till final disposal of the aforesaid revision and he shall be released on bail, provided he executes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance in this court on **18.08.2026** and whenever ordered to do so, till the disposal of the revision on the conditions indicated below:-

1. That he/she/they will appear before the trial Court in the month of January of every year till the revision is decided.
2. That if the applicant(s) changes the place of residence, he/she/they will give in writing

his/her/their changed address to the trial Court as well as to the counsel in the High Court.

3. Similarly, if the sureties change their address(s), they will give in writing their changed address to the trial Court.

The learned trial Court shall keep the record of attendance of the accused-applicant(s) in a separate file. Such file be registered as Criminal Misc. Case related to original case in which the accused-applicant(s) was/were tried and convicted. A copy of this order shall also be placed in that file for ready reference. Criminal Misc. file shall not be taken into account for statistical purpose relating to pendency and disposal of cases in the trial court. In case the said accused applicant(s) does not appear before the trial court, the learned trial Judge shall report the matter to the High Court for cancellation of bail.
