1. Instant bail application is filed by petitioner **Kapil S/o Mahaveer Prasad Rao** under Section 483 of BNSS for interim bail in a matter arising out of FIR No.142/2021 dated 21.10.2021 registered at Police Station Kachhola, District Bhilwara, for offence under Sections 8/15 of NDPS Act.
2. This Court is considering interim bail application of the petitioner-accused on the ground that petitioner-accused is suffering from acute-on-chronic liver failure (ACLF).
2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is suffering from acute-on-chronic liver failure (ACLF) grade III stage and earlier occasion when the interim bail of three months was granted to the petitioner, the petitioner underwent a treatment at

AIIMS, New Delhi, and currently, he is seeking interim bail only to undergo further treatment, which is not available at District Hospital, Bhilwara, as the petitioner is in custody at District Jail, Bhilwara. He also submits that the petitioner is ready to abide by any of the conditions as imposed by this Hon'ble Court and he undertakes during the period, he will not commit any offence or indulge in any criminal activity.

3. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor and submitted a report dated 19.07.2026 received from the Superintendent, District Jail, Bhilwara,

4. Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record.

5. On earlier occasion, the petitioner was granted interim bail on 19.03.2026 for a period of three months on ground for treatment of liver. As petitioner is suffering from acute-on-chronic liver (ACLF) grade III, and he is unable to walk himself or even to rise on his own, thus, considering the medical condition as mentioned in report dated 19.07.2026, and the opinion given by the Medical Officer, District Jail, it is evident that the patient has chronic liver disease, and requiring ongoing specialist care and regular monitoring.

6. Considering the report and also the medical condition, it is appropriate to grant an interim bail to petitioner for a period of thirty days only for purpose of undergoing treatment at AIIMS, Jodhpur.

7. In view of the aforesaid, interim bail application is allowed and petitioner **Kapil S/o Mahaveer Prasad Rao** is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of thirty days from

31.07.2026 to 29.08.2026 on furnishing two sureties of ₹50,000/- each and a personal bond of ₹1,00,000/- to the satisfaction of the trial court with the following conditions:-

1. After release of petitioner on bail, he will not indulge in any criminal activity and if it is found that he is involved in any criminal activity, the order shall be recalled.
 2. During period of interim bail, petitioner will not leave jurisdiction of District Bhilwara and Jodhpur except for commuting from Bhilwara to Jodhpur and return to Bhilwara.
 3. After availing 30 days period of interim bail, he will surrender before the jail authorities on 29.08.2026.
8. Misc. application stands disposed of.
