1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners instead of pressing the present writ petition on merit submits that the petitioners will be satisfied if a liberty is granted to him to approach the respondents by way of filing a fresh representation in the light of judgment rendered by Division Bench of this court in ***D.B. Special Appeal (Writ) No.663/2015 (State of Rajasthan & Anr. v. The Management Committee Sh. Bhagwan Das Todi College)*** decided on 06.11.2015, for redressal of his grievances and the respondents may be directed to consider and decide the same at the earliest.
3. Considering the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty



to the petitioners to file a fresh representation before the respondent authorities for redressal of his grievances.

4. In the event of filing such representation by the petitioners, the same shall be considered in the light of judgment rendered in the case of *State of Raj. & Anr. v. Bhagwan Das Todi College (supra)* and decided by the respondents at the earliest preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of such representation, strictly in accordance with law.
