1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Abhishek Dudi S/o Lalchand** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No. 152 dated 06.04.2026 registered at P.S. Nokha, District Hanumangarh, for the offence under Sections 303(2), 324(4), 352, 351(2), 189(2) of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. She further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. She also submits that the

applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that for incident of 05.04.2026 a report was registered after one day on 06.04.2026 and the main allegation is upon Raju Khichad and not upon present petitioner. She also submitted that present petitioner is not named in FIR. She further submitted that present petitioner was arrested on 23.06.2026 and the offence is triable by Magistrate first class.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of report dated 06.04.2026 for incident of evening of 05.04.2026 lodged by complainant Dharmendra Singh against Raju Khichad and other unknown persons, FIR No. 152/2026 was registered at Police Station Nokha, District Bikaner. Present petitioner is in custody since his arrest. The offence is triable by Magistrate and there is no criminal antecedents against the petitioner.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case

and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.

8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Abhishek Dudi S/o Lalchand**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
