1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in an
identical controversy, a co-ordinate bench of this Court has
granted interim order on 18.12.2025 in the case of ***Ravi Kumar
Bairwa Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors. (SBCWP
No.24663/2025)***. The said order is reproduced hereunder:-

“1. Heard on interim stay application.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the candidature of the petitioner was rejected on the ground that the college, from which, the petitioner obtained diploma course, was not having an NOC from the State Government to run the said course.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner appeared in the entrance examination conducted by the respondent No.3-University and he was allotted the College viz. Shri Sant Veterinary Institute, Abhawas, Sikar in the counselling conducted by the University on the basis of merit. Since the said College was also one of the notified college in the participation in the counselling. And having completed the diploma course by the petitioner from the said College as per the allotment done by the University, when the petitioner applied for the selection to the said post, his candidature, cannot be rejected on the ground that the College, from which, the petitioner has obtained the diploma course, has no NOC.

4. The contention, prima facie, revealed that the admission of the petitioner is not a voluntary act but on account of allocation of the selection counselling process by the University and the said College was given affiliation by the University.

5. In the overall facts and circumstances of the case, the respondents No. 1 to 2 are directed to keep one post vacant of Livestock Assistant in the category of SC, if not already filled-up.

6. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable in four weeks.

7. List the matter on 06.02.2026."

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the candidature of the petitioner was rejected on the ground that the college, from which, the petitioner obtained diploma course, was not having an NOC from the State Government to run the said course.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner appeared in the entrance examination conducted by the respondent No.3-University and he was allotted the College viz. Shri. Jeetendra Godara's SLBS Veterinary Institute, Pali, in the counselling conducted by the University on the basis of merit. Since the said College was also one of the notified college in the participation in the counselling. And having completed the diploma course by the petitioner from the said College as per the allotment

done by the University, when the petitioner applied for the selection to the said post, his candidature, cannot be rejected on the ground that the College, from which, the petitioner has obtained the diploma course, has no NOC.

4. The contention, prima facie, revealed that the admission of the petitioner is not a voluntary act but on account of allocation of the selection counselling process by the University and the said College was given affiliation by the University.

5. In the overall facts and circumstances of the case, the respondents No. 2 to 4 are directed to keep one post vacant of Livestock Assistant in the category of GEN-EWS, if not already filled-up.

6. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable in four weeks.
