Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is pursuing her studies of BHMS Course (Bachelor of Homeopathic Medicine and Surgery) governed by the Homeopathy (Degree Course) BHMS Regulations of 1983. It is contended that vide Circular dated 28.02.2022, respondent No. 2- Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Rajasthan Ayurved University, Karwar, Nagaur Road, Jodhpur, has categorically instructed/informed the Principals of all Homeopathy Colleges affiliated to the University, that the student shall be entitled to 7 attempts to clear all examination instead of 4, as per applicable regulation No. 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that petitioner is otherwise bright student and is willing to appear in her sixth attempt. It is submitted that said examination is for 3<sup>rd</sup> year BHMS which is scheduled to be commenced from 17.07.2026 and she is not allowed to participate in the same. Thus, her entire academic year is being put in jeopardy.

In spite of service upon respondent No. 1- College, no one has put in appearance.

List this matter after four weeks.

In the meanwhile, respondents are directed to provisionally allow the petitioner to participate in 3<sup>rd</sup> year of BHMS examination (for sixth attempt) scheduled to be commenced from 17.07.2026.
