The instant appeals have been filed against the judgment and award dated 06.08.2018 passed by Judge, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Chittorgarh in MAC Case No.683/2010 whereby the learned Tribunal awarded a sum of Rs.5,52,416/- alongwith interest in favour of the claimants.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that they have amicably settled the dispute in the spirit of Lok Adalat and the insurance company has agreed to accept the liability and ready to pay a sum of Rs.5,25,000/- in addition to the amount already paid by the Insurance Company towards full and final settlement of the claim made by the claimants.

Therefore, it is prayed that the present appeals may be disposed of in the light of the memo of understanding entered into between the parties.

In view of above, it is ordered that the above said amount of Rs.5,25,000/- shall be paid by the insurance company to the appellant within a period of two months from today. If the said amount is not paid by the insurance company within a period of two months, the insurance company shall pay interest @ 7% from today on the enhanced amount till the amount is actually paid to the appellant. Upon deposit of above amount, the trial Court is directed to deposit the entire amount in savings bank account of the claimants and not in Fixed Deposit.

The appeals stand disposed of in above terms.

The award is accordingly modified.

Stay petitions and all pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
