Counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties are relatives and the matter can be amicably settled, hence, requests that the matter may be referred for mediation.

In view of aforesaid submission, the present misc. petition is referred to Mediation Centre.

The parties are directed to remain present before the Mediation Centre, Rajasthan High Court, Jodhpur on **28.07.2026 at 11.00 am**. The trained Mediator will thereafter undertake the proceedings of mediation and submit its report before this Court in a sealed envelope on the next date of hearing.

Counsel for the petitioner will give necessary details i.e. contact number of respondent no.2 to the Mediation Centre within two days of uploading of this order, so that notice for appearance and date of mediation could be conveyed.

Till the mediation proceedings are concluded, the petitioners shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.158/2026 of Police Station Dabok, District Udaipur.

However, it is made clear that this order of protection is only passed in order to make the mediation fruitful and if the mediation fails, the Court shall consider granting/extension of the interim order on merits.

List the matter after culmination of mediation proceedings.

A copy of this order be sent to the concerned Mediation Centre forthwith.
