Heard learned counsel of the applicant appellant and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

The instant application for temporary suspension of sentence has been moved on behalf of the appellant-applicant on the ground that he is appearing in the competitive examination. As per the schedule of examinations placed on record, the examination papers in which the applicant appellant is to appear, are to take place between 12.07.2026 to 18.07.2026.

In this background, this Court deems it proper to accept this application for temporary suspension of sentences and enlarge the applicant appellant on interim bail for a period of **one month**.

Accordingly, the instant application for temporary suspension of sentences filed under Section 430 of BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the sentences passed by the learned learned Judge, Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Child Rights Protection Commission Act, 2005, No.01, Bhilwara, vide judgment dated 20.11.2024 in Sessions Case No.07/2024 against the appellant-applicant **Sagar Kumar S/o Shri Shyamlal Teli**, shall remain temporarily suspended and he shall be released on interim bail for a period of **one month** from the date of his release, provided he executes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sound and solvent sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge on usual terms and conditions and upon submitting an undertaking that he shall surrender back upon expiry of the period of temporary suspension of sentences. The Superintendent of the concerned Jail shall give the date of surrender of the petitioner-appellant Sagar Kumar.
