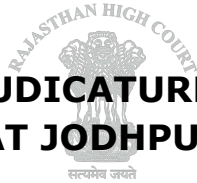

This criminal misc. petition under Section 528 BNSS has been preferred on behalf of petitioner seeking quashing of FIR No.106/2026 registered at Police Station Khamnour, District Rajsamand for the offence under Section 19/54 of Rajasthan Excise Act.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is registered power of attorney-holder of the bus and he has been falsely implicated. He wants to submit a detailed representation alongwith the supporting evidence before the Investigating Officer.

Accordingly, the instant criminal misc. petition is disposed of as not pressed with liberty to the petitioner to submit a detailed

representation to the concerned Investigating Officer averring therein all the grounds which have been raised in this petition within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

In the event, representation is submitted, the concerned Investigating Officer is directed to minutely and objectively consider the contents of the same. All the relevant documents with the representation shall also be taken into consideration.

Till 20 days from the date of filing of representation, the petitioner shall not be arrested in in connection with FIR No.106/2026 registered at Police Station Khamnour, District Rajsamand for the offence under Section 19/54 of Rajasthan Excise Act.

Stay application and all pending applications, if any, stands disposed of accordingly.
