Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if they are permitted to file representations before the respondents in light of judgment passed by Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **The State of Rajasthan & Ors. Vs. Namonarayan Sharma & Ors.** [Civil Appeals Nos. of 2026 (Arising out of S.L.P. (C) Nos.13102-13109

of 2020)]. and the judgment passed by the Co-ordinate Bench at Jaipur in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.13045/2025**.

In view of the limited submissions made, the petitioners would be at liberty to file a detailed representation before the respondents within a period of two weeks from today along with the copy of the aforesaid judgments.

In case, the representations are filed by the petitioners, the respondents are directed to decide the same within a period of six weeks thereafter strictly in accordance with law by way of passing a speaking order.
