1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused Sandeep Bijarniya S/o Krishna Kumar, seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.140/2026 dated 20.06.2026 registered at P.S. Tara Nagar, District - Churu, for the offence under Sections 108 and 3(5) of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are

no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after suicide of Ganesh, his brother Dinesh Kumar has lodged a report against three persons and police has investigated the matter. He submits that except the oral statement of Dinesh Kumar, there is no evidence to support allegation of harassment against the present petitioner. He also submits that the present petitioner is arrested on 22nd June 2026 and he is in custody.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor and learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that there is a suicide note recovered in the instant case wherein harassment against the petitioner is mentioned.
6. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
7. On basis of a report dated 20th June 2026 about abetment of suicide by three persons including present petitioner, FIR No. 146/2026 was registered at P.S. Tara Nagar, District - Churu by Dinesh Kumar after suicide of his brother Ganesh. The matter is at investigation stage and there is one criminal antecedent against the petitioner. The police has recovered a

suicide note and we have considered the same. We have also considered the statements recorded by the police during investigation. The material on record indicate that the deceased has borrowed money from the present petitioner and further landed it to Aarif. The allegation upon the present petitioner is that he has demanded interest more than agreed between the parties and further harassed the deceased.

8. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
9. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Sandeep Bijarniya S/o Krishna Kumar**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.

(iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.

(iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

10. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
