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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE SANDEEP SHAH**  
**Order**

**22/07/2026**

1. The applicants have filed the present bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS being aggrieved against the order dated 29.06.2026 passed by the learned Special Judge (NDPS Cases),



Hanumangarh, in Criminal Miscellaneous Case Nos. 310/2026, 312/2026 & 316/2026, whereby the bail applications filed by the accused-applicants under Section 483 of B.N.S.S. were rejected. The accused-applicants are behind the bars, pursuant to the F.I.R. No.199/2026 registered at Police Station Hanumangarh Sadar, District Hanumangarh, for the offence punishable under Sections 8 & 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submit that the recovered contraband from the applicants is below the threshold limit of commercial quantity, inasmuch as 43.730 kilograms of poppy husk has been recovered from the conscious possession of the applicant – Jasvinder Singh. They further submit that other applicants have been implicated with the aid of Section 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985. They further submit that there is no criminal antecedent of identical nature against any of the applicants. They further submit that the trial is likely to take a sufficiently long time to conclude. They, therefore, implore this Court to allow the present bail applications.

3. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposes the bail applications. However, he is not in a position to dispute the fact that the recovered contraband is below the threshold limit of commercial quantity and there is no criminal antecedent of identical nature against any of the applicants.

4. Heard learned counsel for the applicant as well as the learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.

5. Having considered the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the parties and having regard to the facts and



circumstances of the case, more particularly the facts that the recovered contraband is below the threshold limit of commercial quantity, the applicants are not having any criminal antecedent of identical nature, and the trial is likely to take a sufficiently long time to conclude, this Court *prima facie* finds it to be a fit case to enlarge the accused-applicants on bail.

6. Thus, without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the accused-applicants on bail.

7. Consequently, the bail applications under Section 483 B.N.S.S. are **allowed**. It is ordered that the accused-applicants; **(1) Inderjeet Singh S/o Shri Gurdeep Singh, (2) Jasvinder Singh S/o Sarvjeet Singh & (3) Hanuman Ram S/o Shri Ramniwas Saran** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.199/2026 registered at Police Station Hanumangarh Sadar, District Hanumangarh, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided each of them furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court, for their appearance before that Court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.

8. It is further, made clear that findings recorded/observations made herein-above are for limited purposes of adjudication of bail applications and the same shall not prejudice the trial of the case in any manner.
