1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Ranaram S/o Shri Richpal** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.17/2026 dated 03.02.2026 registered at P.S. Gogameri, District - Hanumangarh, for the offence under Sections 303(2) of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the



applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the petitioner has not been named in FIR. He also submitted that except one case other cases registered against petitioner have already been disposed. He further submitted that the offence is triable by Magistrate first class and petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 24.06.2026.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor.
5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On 03.02.2026 complainant Ramprasad has lodged a report at Police Station Gogameri, District Hanumangarh for incident between 10.12.2025 to 08.01.2026 against a pickup driver and other unknown persons for theft of cotton pods. During investigation present petitioner was arrested on 24.06.2026. As per record, ten criminal cases were registered against petitioner since 1990 and except one case all other cases have been disposed. The offence is triable by Magistrate first class.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case,



the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.

8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Ranaram S/o Shri Richpal**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
