Order

1. The amended cause title has been filed today on instructions of the Court. The same is taken on record.
2. Office to make online amendments.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the dispute pertaining to the recognition of the respondent No.6 Association is going on since 2017 and two parallel associations are functioning since that time. Even writ petitions had been preferred thrice by the petitioners challenging the recognition of respondent No.6 association and its actions at the relevant point of time.
4. Counsel further submits that earlier, twice, when the election of Rajasthan Football Association was sought to be conducted while giving right to vote to respondent No.6 Association, the same was stayed by this Court. However, again the said right has been given to respondent No.6 Association and hence, the present writ petition has been preferred.
5. The matter was heard in the pre lunch session by this Court but as the petitioners were directed to file an amended cause title, the order could not be passed in the pre-lunch session and hence, the matter was posted for post-lunch session.
6. Learned counsel Mr. Moti Singh Rajpurohit submits that he has entered caveat on behalf of respondent No.6 Association

(although there is no such caveat available on record or even reflected to have been filed, on the website of the High Court). He submits that the election process has already been completed in the morning and even the result has been declared. However, the said fact is not available on record before this Court.

7. In view of the submissions made, it is hereby directed that respondent No.6 Association shall not be granted the right to vote in the elections of the Rajasthan Football Association. If the election has already been conducted and the result has been declared, the elected body of the said Association shall be restrained to function till the next date.

8. List the matter on 03.09.2024.

9. Meanwhile, the respondent No.2 Rajasthan Football Association shall be at liberty to summon the representatives of both the Associations and after affording opportunity of hearing to both, proceed on to finally decide the issue pertaining to the recognition of Respondent No.6 Association, strictly in accordance with law, so that the controversy rests decided for all purposes.
