1. According to the petitioner, the road which has been constructed on the land, is owned or possessed by him.
2. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also.
3. Mr. Vinay Chippa accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4.
4. Let notice returnable within six weeks be issued to the respondent Nos.5, 6, 8, 9 and 10. Notice need not to be issued to respondent No.7.
5. Meanwhile, the petitioners shall file a representation before the Secretary UIT and the District Collector, Jaisalmer for determination of the compensation in accordance with law.
6. In case, a representation is so addressed, the competent authority shall determine the compensation in accordance with law.
