Learned counsel for the respondents submits that, in view of the subsequent development, inasmuch as RPSC had issued a Press-Note dated 07.07.2026 (copy whereof is taken on record), which *inter-alia* provides that the candidates who did not appear in the written examination held in February 2021 in pursuance of the earlier advertisement dated 03.12.2021, have now been permitted to appear in the present selection process. He thus submits that now no further relief can be granted to the petitioner because the petitioner's sole prayer is to direct the respondents to accept the examination form in both offline and online modes and

to permit the petitioner to participate in the selection process/examination.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to refute, however, submits that petitioner may be granted liberty to file fresh writ petition, if occasion so arises.

Having regard to the submissions made by counsel for the parties, no substantive relief can be granted in the instant petition, which seeks direction to accept the examination form in offline and online modes and to permit the petitioner to partake in the selection process. The writ petition is, thus, dismissed. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to approach this Court afresh, if and when any grievance arises in relation to the selection process.
